

## Site Identification and Initial Assessment

- 1. In collaboration with school, identify site through historical use by local schools or established criteria
  - 2. Identify preliminary learning assets and amenities of site
  - 3. Identify preliminary challenges and issues of site (safety, access)
  - 4. Determine appropriateness of the property (proximity, access, safety)
  - 5. Determine property ownership

## Landowner

- 1. Prepare landowner and property information
- 2. Contact landowner
  - Communicate idea and intention of Learning Landscapes
  - Determine initial and potential interest
  - Meet with landowner to explore commitment further
  - Follow land transaction process (MOU, easement, acquisition)
